Demonstration given to B.sc nursing IVth semester students about Radient heat warmer or Intensive care warmer. Radiant Warmer, is a body warming device to provide heat to the newborn. This device helps to maintain the body temperature of the newborn baby and limit the metabolism rate. Radiant Warmers can be manual or automatic (servo system – heater output is determined automatically based on skin temperature. The skin temperature is set at 36.5 degree Celsius) depending on the mechanism.
